About this Course

Due to the increasing number of motor vehicle accidents attributed to cell phone and other electronic device use while driving, governments are taking steps to address these hazards. In 2010, The British Columbia government introduced new legislation to regulate the use of electronic device use while on the road. This course will help you understand these new laws.
